These supplies will be collected and/or inspected by homeroom teachers:

- 1 Ream (500 Count) copy paper
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 Hand-held pencil sharpener with shaving catcher
- 1 Pkg. 300 Count Lined 3 x 5 Cards
- 2 Pkgs. of Loose-leaf Notebook Paper (Wide Ruled)
(may need to be replaced during the year)
- 1 – 12 inch ruler with Metric
- 1 pair of student scissors
- 2” Binder for student to carry each day
- 1 Package of #2 pencils – 24 count
- 1 package of ¼” graph paper
- 1 Set of 8 – Subject Dividers for student’s binder
- 4 “COMPOSITION” Books (Wide Ruled)
- 5 pocket folders (with fasteners to hold notebook paper)
- 1 – set of Crayola markers
- Ink Cartridge for Classroom printers -- ***Instead of purchasing an Ink Cartridge, please purchase a \$15.00 Office Depot or Wal-Mart Gift Card and turn it into the front office. These will be catalogued and used to purchase ink cartridges in bulk. This allows families to save several dollars instead of purchasing a specific ink cartridge.

•School approved backpacks will be sold in the front office.

•Students will need the following items to carry at school: Three-ring binder with paper, pen or pencil, and a library book. School books are kept in the classroom along with art supplies.

•Teachers may require additional supplies such as paper and pencils that will need to be replenished. Some items specific to an assignment may be needed throughout the year. Students will be responsible for these supplies.

•Jackets will be kept on the back of the student’s chair. All jackets worn must be solid black in color and may not have a hood.

•Students should not carry: Sharpies, permanent markers, mechanical pencils, aerosol sprays or white out.
